With the opening of the new office, I wanted to let you know testing has started for the Enumerator positions. There are several testing sites open. As you can see, most of the testing sites are North of Summit. We will be opening more sites further south in the next few weeks.

I will be sending my assistant, Kevin McGrier to your offices to drop off brochures and posters, announcing the Census jobs. Please encourage your residents to call the Census phone number, (866) 861-2010 or to visit the Census website:

<http://2010.census.gov/2010censusjobs/>. Each site has different days and times of testing.

When a resident calls, the office will coordinate a location and time that is convenient to the resident. Please remember that this is testing. The hiring will take place after the first of the year. If the resident is hired, they will receive a call. All residents are selected based on their

score on the test. The Census will test up to five times as many people as they need for these positions. The Census wants to hire from within your community.

Lastly, Kevin will also be asking you for potential locations for QAC's (Question and Answer Sites) and BCC's (Be Counted Sites). As you may remember, the QAC's will be a manned table located in a building with high foot traffic. This Census employee will be at the table ready to assist residents in filling out their form. I do not have the amount of hours that this person will be at the table. However, I do know that the tables will be active from March 19 – April 19, 2010. The BCC's will be a Census box that is not manned. The box will contain the form in all five languages along with a return envelope. This is for the resident who misplaced their form or for whatever reason is in need of an additional form.

If you can provide Kevin with location recommendations as well as a name of a contact for that location, this would be most helpful.

Thank you for spreading the word about the Census and the jobs. I will keep you posted on the progress of the jobs and sites as time goes on.
