

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC WORKS AND BUILDING SERVICES



YARD WASTE ...is starting April 4th, and will be picked up on your regular garbage day! All "yard waste" (leaves, plant debris, grass clippings, twigs or small branches, etc.) must be placed in your **"GREEN" yard waste cart**. In addition you may also use your own 32 gallon container that will need to be labeled *"Yard Waste Only"* or a brown yard waste bag. Be sure to have your carts placed on the parkway or driveway apron after 4:00pm the evening before your scheduled pickup day. **Please do not put ANY Carts, Trash or Recycling containers in the street.**



BRANCH PICK-UP...begins on April 4th and will be done once a month. Our Public Works Department documents each street, with the date and time it was finished. They will **NOT** return once they have completed a street. Branch pickup weeks are as follows:

BRANCH PICK UP DATES

April 4th – April 8th
May 9th – May 13th
June 6th – June 10th
July 11th – July 15th

August 8th – August 12th
September 12th – September 16th
October 10th – October 14th

GUIDELINES FOR BRANCH PICK UP

- ◆ Place branches on the Parkway the **Sunday before "Pick-Up Week" begins.**
- ◆ Entire trees will **NOT** be removed. Residents must make arrangements with a hauling service to remove debris when cutting down a tree.
- ◆ Branch piles are **NOT** to exceed 8' long by 5' high by 5' wide.
- ◆ Logs 5' or more in diameter **must be cut into lengths of 2'** or less, stacked and will be picked up separately.
- ◆ Bush roots must be removed and will be picked up separately

PLEASE DO NOT MIX YARD WASTE WITH BRANCHES!



Our **STREET SWEEPING** program with *Waste Management* began in March. During the month of April, the schedule will be April 4th through April 8th and April 18th through April 22nd. Please **DO NOT** park on the street during these scheduled dates.
