No bottled beverages of any kind, i.e. pop, beer or wine will be allowed in the Commons.

No beer, wine, etc. will be allowed in the Commons after 7:00PM

We suggest that you consider walking in order to reduce the traffic problems.

Park in designated areas only. If you park in unauthorized areas, you are subject to being towed.

Due to the large number of people expected at the Commons, we request that no bikes, rollerblades, or skates be brought onto the Commons grounds. Dogs or pets are not allowed at the Commons.

Since tables and chairs are available only to be used under the eating tent. You may want to bring your own. **YOUR COOPERATION IS GREATLY APPRECIATED.**
