Mobile Driver Services Facility is coming to Proviso Township, August 10th!

The Illinois Secretary of State's Mobile Driver Services Facility will offer Driver's License Renewals, duplicate or corrected Driver's Licenses, Vision Screening for Licenses, Illinois Photo Identification Cards, and License Plate Renewal Stickers. Mark your calendars for **Wednesday, August 10 from 10:00AM until 2:00PM** for these services to be held at the office of **Proviso Township, 4565 Harrison Street, in Hillside**. Driver's License renewals can be made up to one year in advance, and all residents of Illinois are eligible to use this facility. Normal issuance and renewal fees will apply, but Illinois residents at least 65 years of age may obtain a photo identification card (not license) at no charge. Sorry, but **NO** road tests will be given at this location.

POLICE OFFICER TESTING...important information from the Fire & Police Commission



The Hillside Board of Fire and Police Commissioners are accepting applications for the purpose of establishing an eligibility list for Police Officer. **Applications may be obtained from the office of the Hillside Village Clerk, 425 Hillside Avenue, Hillside, Illinois, starting Monday, August 29, 2011, between the hours of 9:00AM to 5:00PM, Monday through Friday and 9:00AM to 12:00 Noon on Saturdays.** All completed applications without exception, must be returned to the Village Clerk's office no later than **12:00 Noon on Saturday, September 17, 2011.**

Prospective applicants must be serious and meet the following criteria:

1. **Must be 21 years of age and under 35 years of age. Age hiring limitations imposed by State statute are applicable.**
2. **Must be a U. S. Citizen**
3. **Must have a high school degree or G.E.D. equivalent.**
4. **Must meet the requirements of a background check.**
5. **Must pass a medical, psychological and polygraph test.**
6. **Must have a valid driver's license at time of hiring.**
7. **Must pay a non-refundable fee of \$20.00 for each Application Packet (Sorry no credit cards... cash or check only. Fee must be paid at the time of packet pick up)**

Additional requirements and supporting documentation requested of applicants will be provided as part of the Village's application packet.

The application and examination process are subject to the rules and regulations of the Hillside Fire and Police Commission. There will be a **MANDATORY ORIENTATION** session on **SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24th at 9:00AM** at St. Domitilla School, 605 North Hillside Avenue, Hillside, IL 60162. No admittance will be allowed after 9:00AM. The written testing is scheduled for **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2011 at 9:00AM**. This will also be held at St. Domitilla School.
