BRANCH REMOVAL FOR AUGUST

Branch removal for August will be the week of **August 3rd through August 7th**. **Make sure branches are on the parkway Sunday, August 2nd and leave them there until they are removed that week.** **We will not return once a street has been completed.** **September pick-up will be the 8th through September 11th.** Please place branches out **September 7th**.



STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of **August 3rd-August 7th** and **August 17th-August 21st**. Please refrain from parking on the streets from **6:00am** until **4:30pm** during these dates.



50/50 SIDEWALK PROGRAM

The Village offers the public sidewalk program to all residents that want to replace damaged sidewalk squares under the “50/50” program. If this is something you are interested in, please call Public Works at (708) 202-3434 to schedule an appointment to assess the sidewalk condition. We will leave a contract with the recommended repairs/replacement and total cost to you, which you would sign and be required to pay prior to scheduling with our contractor. This work takes place two (2) times per year, typically late Spring to early Summer and late Summer to Fall. Please call us with any questions you may have.



BUILDING DEPARTMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES INFORMATION

A Home Inspection is required if you are planning to sell your house. Please call to get information or come into the Village Hall between the hours of **7:00am and 3:30pm** so we can answer all your questions and you can be more informed about selling your property. If you are ***planning to rent your house***, a ***Village Rental Inspection is required and must be inspected prior to tenants moving in.*** You must also have a ***final water reading.*** A Sewer Connection Inspection is required for all commercial property selling in the Village. Please call for all the information. **Permits are required for all work performed by a resident and/or contractor.** You may obtain applications at the front counter of the Village Hall.

All contractors doing work in Hillside must be licensed and bonded with the Village of Hillside.

NOTE: All inspection fees must be paid prior to scheduling any appointments.



CODE ENFORCEMENT

All single family home properties in Hillside, that will be vacant, must be registered with the Village. Contact information for this property must be given for record purposes. Property must be secured and properly maintained to avoid action by Code Enforcement.

TUESDAY, AUGUST 11TH RECKLESS




Question...What can you expect at a **RECKLESS** performance???
