SUMMER SAFETY TIPS FROM OUR FIRE DEPARTMENT



Summer means *vacation, outdoor activities* and *fun in the sun*, so here are some important tips for you...

POOL SAFETY: Watch children when they are in or around water, keeping young children within arms reach of an adult and making sure older children swim with a partner. Know what to do in an emergency. **Learning CPR** and basic water rescue skills may save a life. **WEATHER SAFETY:** Drink plenty of water and natural juices, even if you don't feel thirsty. Wear light colored, loose fitting clothing. Reduce, eliminate, or reschedule strenuous activities. **Do NOT leave children or pets in ANY vehicle for ANY amount of time.** **SEVERE WEATHER:** Develop a disaster plan for you and your family for home, work, school, and when you are outdoors. Check the weather forecast before leaving for extended periods of time and of course, don't forget about pets. **Have a safe and fun-filled month of August!**

BRANCH REMOVAL FOR AUGUST

Branch removal for August will be the week of **August 1st through August 5th**. **Make sure branches are on the parkway Sunday and leave them there until they are removed that week.**

We will not return once a street has been completed. September pick-up will be the **6th through September 9th**. Please place branches out **September 5th**. In addition to the Hillside branch pick-up, Waste Management will also remove small branches, approximately 2' long, 2' high and 2' wide, bundled with twine. Waste Management will remove these on your regular garbage pick-up day.



STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of **August 1st-August 5th** and **August 15th-August 19th**. Please refrain from parking on the streets from **6:00AM** until **4:30PM** during these dates.



50/50 SIDEWALK PROGRAM

The Village offers the public sidewalk program to all residents that want to replace damaged sidewalk squares under the "50/50" program. If this is something you are interested in, please call Public Works at **(708) 202-3434** to schedule an appointment to assess the sidewalk condition. We will leave a contract with the recommended repairs/replacement and total cost to you, which you would sign and be required to pay prior to scheduling with our contractor. This work takes place two (2) times per year, typically late Spring to early Summer and late Summer to Fall. Please call us with any questions you may have.



BUILDING DEPARTMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES INFORMATION

A Home Inspection is required if you are planning to sell your house. Please call to get information or come into the Village Hall between the hours of **7:00am and 3:30pm** so we can answer all your questions and you can be more informed about selling your property. If you are **planning to rent your house**, a **Village Rental Inspection is required and must be inspected prior to tenants moving in.** You must also have a **final water reading.** A Sewer Connection Inspection is required for all commercial property selling in the Village. Please call for all the information. **NOTE: All inspection fees must be paid prior to scheduling any appointments. Permits are required for all work performed by a resident and/or contractor.** You may obtain applications at the front counter of the Village Hall. **All contractors doing work in Hillside must be licensed and bonded with the Village of Hillside.** You can obtain the Contractors Requirements for permitting on the Village website.



CODE ENFORCEMENT

All single family home properties in Hillside, that will be vacant, must be registered with the Village. Contact information for this property must be given for record purposes. **Property must be secured and properly maintained to avoid action by Code Enforcement.**
