From the Desk of the Mayor....

LANDFILL UPDATE

In accordance with the consent order signed by Allied Waste on March 12, 2007, work on the landfill closure continues to progress at a rapid pace. Activities that have been occurring since November, 2007 include:

- Allied Waste has condensed several of the remaining filling phases to bring the entire 55 acre site near final design grade for closure.
- As of this writing, it is anticipated that drilling operations associated with the installation of new gas collection wells and new leachate monitoring wells for all phases of final closure should have been completed at the end of January. Unfortunately, these operations have been the primary source of odor as this work progresses and scheduling of these activities has been affected by adverse weather conditions such as rapid thaw and rainfall.
- Again, as of this writing, the new leachate pretreatment facility was expected to be complete with construction by the end of January with facility testing being conducted this month and facility operation in the beginning of March.

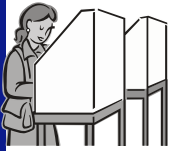
A new enclosed flare used to destroy landfill gases arrived at the landfill in December and is expected to be installed for operation in March.

Although this work is necessary to provide a final and proper closure of this landfill, we appreciate your patience and encourage you to continue to call the Landfill Hotline at **708-202-4320** to report incidents of odor. **Remember, every call is listened to, answered and documented.**

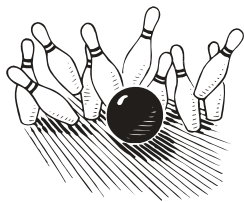


PRIMARY ELECTION - TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2008

2007 Holiday Ornament Decorating Contest

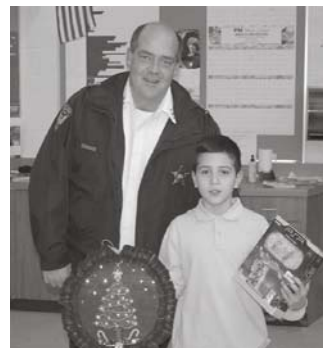

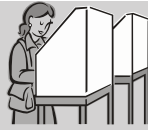
