SNOW ACCUMULATION

Parking is not permitted on any public street within the Village when snow accumulation reaches three inches (3") or more until snow removal operations are completed.




SHOVELING YOUR SNOW

Please do not shovel or blow snow into or across any public street or sidewalk. (Code of Ordinance Section 9.108.1). Icy patches and frozen blocks of ice can form, which are a danger to pedestrians and vehicles in subsequent snowstorms. **Please keep the snow on your own property and parkway.**




NOTE TO OUR RESIDENTS

Garbage, recycle, and yard waste carts, by Ordinance (Article 1, Sec. 70-33), must be put out on the parkway and **NOT IN THE STREET**. The Public Works Department is unable to maintain our streets (snow plowing) with these obstacles on the street. Please place your carts on the parkway.



SUMP PUMP DISCHARGE

All residents must comply with proper discharge of your storm water sump pump. Water must be directed so that the grass areas existing in your front or back yard may readily absorb the runoff without creating a flooding and/or icing conditions to adjacent properties or public ways. Improper discharge will create a public nuisance as stated in Section 21.305 (Nuisance) of the Municipal Code of Ordinances.



DISPOSAL OF TELEVISIONS

The Village of Hillside and Waste Management will **NOT** pick-up televisions at curbside. Televisions have many toxic materials and should not be disposed of in landfills. It is the responsibility of the owner to dispose of electronics properly. The Village of Hillside and the Hillside Library temporarily have a recycling bin where you can dispose of your electronics properly. However, if your TV is larger than 30", you must use an alternate recycling facility that accepts all sizes of working and non-working items.



GOODWILL ACCEPTS WORKING AND NON-WORKING ELECTRONICS

GOODWILL, in the shopping mall on 31st and Wolf Road in Westchester, is considered a recycling facility that accepts all sizes of electronics. If you have a question, please call Goodwill direct at **(708)562-6166**.



PARKWAY TREE REMOVALS

Currently the Village is removing parkway Ash trees that have been infected by the Emerald Ash Borer Disease. Winkler Tree Service, Inc. is the hired contractor for this project and will continue to remove the infected trees throughout the Village as long as weather permits.

IMPORTANT WATER RATE INFORMATION FOR OUR RESIDENTS

In November, 2011, the Village of Hillside received notice from the City of Chicago that effective, January 1, 2012 water rates would be scheduled to increase over the next four years in the following increments: 25% in 2012; 15% in 2013; 15% in 2014; 15% in 2015. As a result of this notification, The Village of Hillside has increased its water rate from \$10.55 to \$10.90 per thousand gallons for all water with a billing date that started January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. The total water rate will include the sewer charge of \$0.45 per thousand gallons bringing the total cost per thousand gallons for water and sewer to \$11.00.



SAFETY CHECKLIST FROM YOUR FIRE DEPARTMENT!



- **TEST YOUR SMOKE ALARM**-Install a smoke alarm on every floor of your home and outside all sleeping areas. Test the smoke alarms once a month and change the batteries twice a year.
- **PLAN YOUR ESCAPE**-Create and practice a home escape plan with your family.
- **KEEP MATCHES AND LIGHTERS IN A SAFE PLACE**-Always keep matches and lighters stored high in a locked cabinet or locked box. Kids imitate adults, set a safe example.
- **COOK SAFELY**-Never leave cooking unattended and keep the cooking area clutter free.
- **GIVE SPACE HEATERS SPACE**-Keep anything that can burn three feet away from portable heaters.
- **EXTINGUISH SMOKING MATERIALS**-Before emptying the contents of an ashtray into the trash, wet the contents.
- **ELECTRICAL SAFETY**-Replace damaged electrical cords and repair or replace appliances that smell, smoke, or overheat.
