from **10AM until 2:00PM** for these services

to be held at the office of Proviso Township,

4565 Harrison Street, in Hillside. Driver's License renewals can be

made up to one year in advance and all residents of Illinois are

eligible to use this facility. Normal issuance and renewal fees will

apply, but Illinois residents at least 65 years of age may obtain a

photo identification card (not license) at no charge. Sorry but NO road tests will be given at this location. If you have any questions, please call the township office at (708) 449-4300.

IDES OF MARCH**





BLACKBOARD CONNECT...



This article is worth repeating...in February, 2009, the Village Board instrumented a communications program that allows Village Officials and Departments to notify residents and businesses of important information concerning our community. We are extremely committed to stay in contact with our residents and businesses in town. The Village uses Blackboard Connect ("robo" call) to send out periodic cell phone, telephone and email messages on matters of importance. This service allows you to receive messages and review them when it's most convenient for you. We at the Village of Hillside believe that this process helps us to better communicate with our residents. **We are asking residents who have not signed up for this service to please do so.** We want everyone to be able to receive important phone calls and/or emails concerning power outages, weather alerts, flooding and other information pertinent to our community or your section of town. If you want only to receive email notifications and not phone calls, enter the information required and then enter **999999999** in the telephone field. You may also stop in at the Village Hall and fill out the form.



Be a Pro-Active Citizen Reminders from our Police Department



Remember to call the police non-emergency number if you are going to have a car parked on the street overnight, so you can avoid a parking ticket.
Dogs must be on a leash at all times, and owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
Cross at crosswalks as officers will be enforcing the "jaywalking" ordinances.
Curfew is 10:30pm Sunday-Thursday, 11:30pm Friday and Saturday for those under 17 years old.

FROM PUBLIC WORKS AND BUILDING SERVICES

BRANCH REMOVAL FOR JULY

Branch removal for **July** will be the week of **July 7th through July 11th**. Place your branches on the parkway **Sunday, July 6th** and leave them until they are removed that week. For the month of **August** we will pick up **August 4th through August 8th**. Place branches on the parkway **Sunday, August 3rd**. **We will not return once a street has been completed.**



STREET SWEEPING

The street sweeper will be cleaning our streets **July 7th through July 11th** and **July 21st through July 25th**. For the month of August the sweeper will be out **August 4th through August 8th** and **August 18th through August 22nd**. **Please DO NOT park on the street when the street sweeper will be present.**



GARBAGE REMOVAL

Place your garbage, recycle and yard waste carts out to the curb after 4:00pm the evening before your pick-up day, and no later than 6:00am the day of your removal. **PLEASE...Do not place your carts in the street!** We have been receiving many calls about critters chewing holes in the garbage carts. Two things you can do to combat this from happening are to wash the carts regularly and/or double bag your garbage, especially in the summer. By cutting down on the smells that animals are attracted to, you will help eliminate this problem.



YARD WASTE

Additional yard waste that does not fit in the Green Cart may be placed in brown yard waste bags for removal. For service related issues, please call **Waste Management Customer Service at 1-800-796-9696**. Residents are allowed one large item per week; however, please call Waste Management in case they have special instructions on an item. Questions regarding the Village's Solid Waste Program, or service for carts, please call the Public Works Department at **(708) 202-3434**.



WATER RESTRICTIONS IN FORCE

Outdoor water use is allowed before noon and after 6 p.m. for even-numbered street addresses on the even-numbered days of the month and odd-numbered addresses on odd-numbered days of the month (Sec. 94-37 Village Code) Restrictions started o May 15th and goes through September 15th.



MOSQUITO INFORMATION—REDUCING THE RISK OF MOSQUITO BITES

As temperatures increase, avoid outdoor activity if possible from dusk to dawn when the mosquitoes bit the most. If you do go out, wear light color, loose fitting clothing and put on insect repellent (always read label warnings and directions). Make sure mosquitoes do not enter homes through unscreened or broken doors or windows. Residents are encouraged NOT to create mosquito harborage or resting areas. Make sure tall grassy areas are trimmed and other necessary vegetation is cut back. If plants must be watered, do so in the morning so the vegetation and soil has a chance to dry making it less attractive to mosquitoes. Empty any containers holding stagnating water for 7 days or longer.



Residents can take the following simple steps to eliminate potential sources for these mosquitoes:

Maintain swimming pools properly (swimming pool codes will be strictly enforced); throw away all trash that can hold water; clean rain gutters and downspouts; change water in bird baths at least once a week; stack pails, barrels, tubs, etc. upside down; stock ornamental ponds with goldfish or other surface-feeding fish to control mosquito production.
