### CLEAN UP WEEK...May 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>

The weather is warming up and everyone is finally coming out of "winter hibernation". This the perfect time to do some "SPRING CLEANING" and clean OUT that dreaded crawl space, basement, garage and attic. Residents are encouraged to remove any unwanted trash, furniture, appliances, etc. which have accumulated over the years. Please place all of these items out on your **REGULAR COLLECTION DAY THAT COINCIDES WITH THE DAYS OF CLEAN UP WEEK LISTED ABOVE and that are on the calendar in this issue of the "Happenings"**.

**Acceptable items** are: **Appliances** (stoves, refrigerators, etc), **Bulk Items** (bicycles, toys, etc), **Carpet**/must be in rolls no more than 5 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter, **Fixtures** (toilets, sinks, etc.), **Furniture, Paint** (must be hardened in cans with lids OFF), **Landscaping timbers**, must be no longer than 3 feet in length.

**Non Acceptable items** are: Car Batteries, Explosives, Tires, any type of Fluid (gas, oil, etc.), Ammunition, Radioactive Material, Riding Lawnmowers/Snow blowers, Hazardous or Medical Waste, Large Automobile Parts, Boats, Snowmobiles, Bricks, Concrete Blocks, Cement or Asphalt Pavement Material, Construction and Demolition debris.



### SPRING CLEAN UP

**Week of MAY 17TH THROUGH 21ST on your REGULAR Garbage Day**  
SEE MAYOR'S COLUMN FOR ALL DETAILS

► **STREET SWEEPING** for the month of May will be the weeks of May 3rd through May 7th and May 31st through June 4th. Please **REFRAIN** from parking on streets from 6:00AM to 4:30PM during these dates.



► **YARD WASTE WILL BE PICKED UP ON YOUR GARBAGE DAY**

Yard waste (leaves, plant debris, grass clippings, etc.) must be placed in your green yard waste cart, a brown yard waste bag, or your own 32 gal. container labeled "Yard Waste Only". Be sure to have your carts ready for pick-up after 4:00 p.m. the evening before your scheduled pick-up day.

► **BRANCH PICK-UP**

Branch pick-up has begun and will be done **once a month**. Our Public Works Department documents each street, with the time and date it was completed, so they will not return once they have completed a street.

### GUIDELINES

- Place branches on parkway the Sunday before pick-up week begins.
- Entire trees will not be removed. Make arrangements with a hauling service to remove debris when cutting down a tree.
- Branch piles not to exceed 8' long by 5' high by 5' wide.
- Logs 5' or more in diameter must be cut into lengths of 2' or less, stacked and will be picked up separately.
- Bush roots must be removed and will be picked up separately.

**PLEASE...DO NOT** mix yard waste with branches.
