### Village to Make Water System Improvements

Through continued efforts to evaluate the reliability of the Village Water System, two areas have been identified for improvement in spring of 2007. The areas that will be addressed include **Westwood Drive, Terrace Lane, High Ridge Parkway** and **Edgewater Avenue (Oakridge Avenue to East Avenue)**. The Village has begun engineering the replacement of water main on these streets and will solicit contractor bids over the winter for spring 2007 construction. Work will include the installation of new water main, reconnecting residential water services, and restoring areas where work is done.

## YARD WASTE

Yard waste pick-up is in effect until the end of December. JUST A REMINDER; to dispose of leftover branches (4' long and up to 2" in diameter) bundle with "natural fiber" twine, place a yard waste sticker on the twine and place at the curb on your regular garbage removal day. Left over leaves can be placed in a yard waste bag or a clean garbage can, a sticker placed on it and put curbside for removal on garbage removal day.



## STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of November 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> and November 27<sup>th</sup> - December 1<sup>st</sup>, weather permitting. Please refrain from parking on Village streets from 6:00am to 4:30pm during these dates.



## SNOW REMOVAL

Parking is not permitted on any public street or alley within the Village when snow accumulation reaches three inches (3") or more until snow removal operations are completed.

Please do not shovel or blow snow into or across any public street or sidewalk (Code of Ordinance's Sec. 74-9). Icy patches and frozen blocks of ice form, creating hazardous conditions for pedestrians and vehicles. Please keep the snow on your own property and parkway.
