GUIDELINES

Leaves should be raked to the curb two (2) days prior to removal date.

Leaves **must** be on the parkway raked to the curb. Leaves raked into the street **will not** be removed by Public Works or our contracted street sweeper.


Leaves picked up with a lawn mower are considered yard waste and must be disposed of as yard waste.

Grass clippings, flowers, garden and vegetable plants, vines, corn stalks and any other miscellaneous plants must be disposed of as yard waste.

All yard or tree debris (other than leaves) can be disposed of as yard waste.

Do not place branches, wood or steel rods in leaf piles.

JUST A REMINDER:

The yard waste program is still in effect until the end of December. To dispose of **leftover leaves and branches** (cut no longer than 4' and up to 2" in diameter) you may do so by:

- Bundling branches with natural fiber twine or place in container.
- Tag each bundle or container with a yard waste sticker.

Place branch bundles or containers at the curb on your regular garbage removal day.



STREET SWEEPING:

Street sweeping is scheduled for October 16th – 20th and October 30th – November 3rd. Please refrain from parking on the streets from 6:00am until 4:30pm during these dates.
