BRANCH PICKUP – LAST PICK-UP

Our **last** branch pick-up in October will be the week of **October 7th through October 11th**. Please **place your branches out by Sunday, October 6th**. If you have branches **after this week** you will have to use your **GREEN** yard waste cart which is picked up on your garbage day, OR bundle branches, not to exceed 2'x2'x2', secure with twine and Waste Management will remove until yard waste ends in December. **Reminder:** Branch pick-up is a service we provide to allow residents to dispose of tree branches that fall throughout the year and minor trimming of your trees when in need. Only a reasonable amount of branches will be removed on pickup day (no more than 5' high x 5' wide x 8' long).

STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of **September 30th–October 4th...October 14th–October 18th...October 28th–November 1st**. Please refrain from parking on the streets from 6:00am until 4:30pm during these dates.

SENIOR SNOW PLOWING

Enrollment forms and additional information will be available in the Village Hall starting **October 1st** and must be returned by **October 31st**. **If you were on the snow plowing list last year, a form will be mailed to you by October 1st.**

The following requirements must be met to be eligible for the plowing:

- A person must be 65 years or older, retired and live in a single residence home.
- No able-bodied or employed persons under 65 can reside in the household.
- Minimum of 3" of snow, per snow event, must fall and all Village streets and alleys must be cleared before any senior plowing will be done. Call Public Works at **(708) 202-3434** if you have any questions.



WATER RESTRICTIONS

Water restrictions are no longer in force for this year. They will begin again May 1, 2014.

Pillars of Honor

The **Village of Hillside**, along with **Sheet Metal Workers' Union Local 73** and **Pillars of Honor, Inc.** proudly invite you to join us for a very **special day in honor of our Veterans** on **Sunday, November 3rd at 2:00PM** at the **Sheet Metal Workers' Local 73 Union Hall, 4500 Roosevelt Road in Hillside**. This amazing **FREE** event will honor **World War II Veterans**, but please know that all Veterans are invited. The model of the **World War II Memorial in Washington, DC** will be unveiled during this program. **Pillars of Honor, Inc.** is a local non-profit organization dedicated to honoring World War II Veterans unable to travel to Washington, DC to see their Memorial in person. This is the original scale model that was used by Senator Bob Dole to present the Memorial design to Congress. It was designed by Friedrich St. Florian from Providence, RI. **Pillars of Honor, Inc.** has this model on loan for a limited time before it will be returned and placed in the Smithsonian. experience gives Veterans the opportunity to learn about their Memorial, talk with other Veterans and reflect upon the sacrifices they and others made during one of the most trying times in the history of the United States. PREVENT KITCHEN FIRES
GO TO FPW.ORG AND GET COOKIN' WITH FIRE SAFETY!



Cooking brings family and friends together, provides an outlet for creativity and can be relaxing. But did you know that cooking fires are the number one cause of home fires and home injuries? By following a few safety tips you can prevent these fires.

Cook with Caution...be alert! If you are sleepy or have consumed alcohol don't use the stove or stovetop. Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling or broiling food. Turn off the stove if you leave the kitchen. Use a timer when you are baking or roasting food...**always remain home while food is cooking.** Keep anything that can catch fire **away from the stovetop. If you have a cooking fire...Just get out of the house but close the door behind you to contain the fire. Call 9-1-1.** Make sure **everyone is out of the house. Keep a lid nearby** when you are cooking to smother small grease fires. Smother the fire by sliding the lid over the pan and turn off the stovetop. Leave the pan covered until it is completely cooled. **If you have a fire in the oven, turn off the heat and keep the oven closed!**
