HILLSIDE FIRE DEPARTMENT IS HAVING A FOOD DRIVE AND THEY NEED YOUR HELP!



BRANCH PICKUP – LAST PICK-UP

Our **last** branch pick-up in October will be the week of **October 6th through October 10th**. Please **place your branches out by Sunday, October 5th**. If you have branches after this week you will have to use your **GREEN** yard waste cart which is picked up on your garbage day, OR bundle branches, not to exceed 2'x2'x2', secure with twine and Waste Management will remove until yard waste ends in December. **Reminder:** Branch pick-up is a service we provide to allow residents to dispose of tree branches that fall throughout the year and minor trimming of your trees when in need. Only a reasonable amount of branches will be removed on pickup day (no more than 5' high x 5' wide x 8' long).



IMPORTANT!!!! GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE CARTS ORDINANCE...PLEASE READ CAREFULLY **Sec. 70-33. Placing receptacles or waste in right-of-way; title to waste.**

(a) Use of receptacles required; time for placement and removal. No garbage or refuse of any kind shall be placed for collection on the paved portion of any street right-of-way, nor shall such garbage or refuse be placed for collection on any parkway, except within cans or containers designed as receptacles thereof and in such a manner as would reasonably assure that the garbage and refuse would not be blown about nor scattered by the wind, animals or vandals. No cans, sealed trash bags or other trash containers shall be placed on any parkway prior to 4:00pm of the day before the scheduled pick-up day for that particular area, and such containers shall be removed before midnight of the actual pick-up day.



STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of **October 13th-October 17th** and **October 27th-October 31st**. Please refrain from parking on the streets from **6:00am** until **4:30pm** during these dates.



SENIOR SNOW PLOWING

Enrollment forms and additional information will be available in the Village Hall starting **October 1st** and must be returned by **October 31st**. If you were on the snow plowing list last year, an enrollment form will be mailed to you by **October 1st**.

The following requirements must be met to be eligible for the plowing:

- A person must be 65 years or older, retired and live in a single residence home.
- No able-bodied or employed persons under 65 can reside in the household.
- Minimum of 3" of snow, per snow event, must fall and all Village streets and alleys must be cleared before any senior plowing will be done. Call Public Works at (708) 202-3434 if you have any questions.



WATER RESTRICTIONS

Water restrictions are no longer in force for this year. They will begin again May 1, 2015.

Tuesday, October 7th is the last day to register to vote at the Hillside Village Hall.** "Early Voting" starts on October 20th through November 2nd. Hours are 9:00AM to 5:00PM. The closest places to Hillside for "Early Voting" are: **Bellwood Village Hall, 3200 Washington, 547-3500** and the **Melrose Park Village Hall, 1000 N. 25th Avenue, 343-4000**.
