POLICE OFFICER TESTING...important information from the FIRE & POLICE COMMISSION

The Hillside Board of Fire and Police Commissioners are accepting applications for the purpose of establishing an eligibility list for Police Officers. *Applications may be obtained from the office of the Hillside Village Clerk, 425 Hillside Avenue, Hillside, Illinois between the hours of 9:00AM to 5:00PM, Monday through Friday and 9:00AM to 12:00 Noon on Saturdays.* All completed applications WITHOUT EXCEPTION, must be returned to the Village Clerk's office no later than 12:00 Noon on Saturday, September 17, 2011.

Prospective applicants must be serious and meet the following criteria:

1. Must be 21 years of age and under 35 years of age. Age hiring limitations imposed by State statute are applicable.
2. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
3. Must have a high school degree or G.E.D.
4. Must meet the requirements of a background check.
5. Must pass a medical, psychological and polygraph test.
6. Must have a valid driver's license at time of hiring.
7. Must **pay a non-refundable fee of \$20.00** for each Application Packet. (Sorry no credit cards...cash or check only. Fee must be paid at the time of packet pick up)

Additional requirements and supporting documentation requested of applicants will be provided as part of the Village's application packet.

The application and examination process are subject to the rules and regulations of the Hillside Fire and Police Commission. There will be a **MANDATORY ORIENTATION** session on **SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24th at 9:00AM** at St. Domitilla School, 605 North Hillside Avenue, Hillside, IL 60162. *No admittance will be allowed after 9:00AM.* The written testing is scheduled for **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2011 at 9:00AM.** This will also be held at St. Domitilla School.

FOOD DRIVE...AND NEED YOUR HELP!**





SENIOR SNOW PLOWING




Enrollment forms will be available in the Village Hall starting **October 1st** and must be returned by **October 31st**. Each year a *new enrollment form must be filled out*.

The following requirements must be met to be eligible for the plowing:

- A person must be 65 years or older, retired and live in a single residence home.
- No able-bodied or employed persons under 65 can reside in the household.
- Minimum of 3" of snow must fall and all Village streets and alleys must be cleared before any senior plowing will be done.

BRANCH REMOVAL for SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER

Branch removal will be the week of **September 12th** through **September 16th**. Make sure branches are on the parkway **Sunday, September 11th**, and leave them until they are removed. **Branch removal will be the week of October 10th through October 14th**. Make sure branches are on the parkway on **Sunday, October 9th**.

We will not return once a street has been completed.

NOTE: If you have branches at another time of the month, you can cut them up and place them into your yard waste cart, or you can bundle branches and secure with twine and put them out for Waste Management to pick-up on your regular garbage day.



STREET SWEEPING

Street sweeping is scheduled for the weeks of **September 6th — September 9th** and **September 19th — September 23rd**.

Please refrain from parking on the streets from 6:00am until 4:30pm during these dates.
