Mayor Tamburino explained the Zoning Board of Appeals and
the Plan Commission dating back to 1980. He also explained
currently, there is very little activity for the Plan
Commission except for map changes and there have only been
three map changes in the last thirty years. Mayor Tamburino
also said this is a good time to merge the groups because
there is only one person on the Plan Commission and a
vacancy on the Zoning Board of Appeals.


Trustee Kramer asked if Zoning Board of Appeals would then
