VILLAGE OF HILLSIDE PLUMBING GUIDELINES

All plumbing work must have a permit.

The Village of Hillside follows the most current Chicago Plumbing Code.

SINGLE FAMILY/RESIDENTIAL

<u>Under Ground:</u> 4" cast iron, drainage, waste, vent, known as DWV. <u>Above Ground:</u> Copper, PVC, galvanized, cast iron.

• Copper must be Type M or better.

DWV Copper is <u>NOT</u> allowed.

COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

Under Ground: 4" minimum cast iron, drainage, waste, vent.

Above Ground: Copper, galvanized or cast iron.

PVC is <u>NOT</u> allowed in <u>ANY</u> Commercial Buildings.

OTHER PERTINENT REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Wet vents are not allowed. Residential dishwashers must use Wye Tailpiece. Dishwasher discharge cannot hook up to disposal.
- 2. Lawn Sprinkling Systems must have an approved R.P.Z. device. All devices must be certified and inspected when installed and every 12 months thereafter.
- 3. Homeowners may do their own plumbing, but must follow the current codes.
- 4. **Commercial buildings** must use an Illinois licensed plumber, registered with the State of Illinois.
