MINUTES FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING AT THE MUNICIPAL COMPLEX, 425 HILLSIDE AVENUE, HILLSIDE, IL 60162 AT 7:30 P.M. MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2023

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

To consider the petition of SRI Meethu LLC, the owners of the property at 12045 West Roosevelt Road, also known as 1200 Hamilton Avenue, Elmhurst, in unincorporated Cook County, to vacate a portion of the unimproved Turner Avenue right-of-way to SRI Meethu LLC for its fair market value.

Motion to approve/deny the petition of SRI Meethu LLC, the owners of the property at 12045 West Roosevelt Road, also known as 1200 Hamilton Avenue, Elmhurst, in unincorporated Cook County, to vacate a portion of the unimproved Turner Avenue right-of-way to SRI Meethu LLC for its fair market value.

DISCUSSION:

Administrator Pisano explained the purpose of this hearing is to discuss the vacation of a roadway that is adjacent north of Westdale Gardens.

Attorney Deady then explained the Village of Hillside is being asked by the petitioner to vacate what is an unimproved roadway that is immediately west of the corporate limits of the Village of Hillside, which is Queen of Heaven cemetery on the south side of Roosevelt Road and the cities and municipalities have jurisdiction over any right of way adjacent to their boundaries, if there is no other municipality. This is not something the County Board has authority under the Illinois Municipal Code to do. Only the Village of Hillside can grant this request. Attorney Deady then asked is someone was here for the petitioner.

Tim Foley, attorney for SRI Meethu, LLC asked if there were any questions he could answer. Mayor Tamburino said he is looking for a few more pieces of information that he will get in his research, but not questions he would ask. He said when this item comes up for a vote in the Regular Board Meeting he will make a motion to table this item until he gets the information he is looking for.

As there was no further discussion before the Board, Mayor Tamburino entertained a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing.
