



Most Common Projects Requiring Permits

Please note this list is not exhaustive and only includes some of the most common projects.

- Any new building or addition to buildings
- New or replacement detached garage, yard sheds, fences
- Signs
- Swimming pools, ponds, spas two feet or more in depth
- Revisions to electrical service, new circuits, receptacles, and light fixtures
- New or replacement furnaces, boilers, and air conditioning units
- Relocation of plumbing fixtures
- Sewer and water line repairs
- Installation of sewer cleanouts, flood control valves, and overhead sewers
- Changes in grade to your lot
- Water heater
- New construction, additions, or remodeling
- Alterations and repairs that are structural such as brickwork, adding a domer and foundation drainage.
- New electrical wiring and distribution equipment
- New or relocated plumbing supply, drain, waste, vent or gas piping
- Driveways, patios, decks, walks
- Installation of sprinkler system, swimming pool, fence, or storage shed
- Installation of windows and doors
